The limit on secondary emissions radiated from the receiving equipment at radio stations that perform communication for testing land mobile stations of a DSRC system, base stations of a DSRC system, and the radio equipment at land mobile stations of a DSRC system within which the function of other radio equipment will not be impaired shall be stipulated pursuant to the provisions of Article 24 paragraph 6 of the Ordinance Regulating Radio Equipment (Radio Regulatory Commission Regulations No. 18 of 1950), as follows.

Ministry of Posts and Telecommunications Announcement No. 530 of 1997 (the announcement stipulating the limit on secondary emissions radiated from the receiving equipment at land mobile stations of an ETC (electronic toll collection) system and base stations of an ETC system within which the function of other radio equipment will not be impaired) shall be repealed.
