a. Partial Amendment to the Regulations for Telecommunications Numbers

(Consultation No. 1176 of June 21, 2007)

Summary

The sub-council reported to MIC that it is appropriate to amend the Regulations to allow the combination of OAB-J numbers and numbers with 050 prefix for FMC service as per the draft MIC ordinance on which it re-invited public comment.

b. Authorization of Changes to Interconnection Tariffs concerning Category I Designated Telecommunications Facilities of Nippon Telegraph and Telephone East Corporation and Nippon Telegraph and Telephone West Corporation (Changes to the collocation procedures, etc. in accordance with the partial amendment to the Regulations for Enforcement of the Telecommunications Business Law and such)

Summary

Considering the two public comment invitation procedures as well as the results of the study at the Interconnection Committee, the sub-council deliberated the matter today and reported to MIC that it is appropriate to authorize the tariffs only after revising them.
