



CHECKLIST OF REQUIREMENTS

- Use of StaySafe.ph or any Contact Tracing Tool
- Availability of temperature or thermal scanner to assess employees, clients and visitors
- Availability of health declaration sheet for employees and clients
- Availability of isolation area for identified symptomatic employees
