

MIC Notice No. 638

Pursuant to the provision of Form 7 of the Ordinance concerning Technical Regulations Conformity Certification, Etc. of Specified Radio Equipment (MPT Ordinance No. 37 of 1981), which shall apply with the replacement pursuant to the provision of Article 15 of the Ordinance for Enforcement of the Act for Implementation of the Mutual Recognition between Japan and Foreign States in Relation to Results of Conformity Assessment Procedures of Specified Equipment (MIC/METI Ordinance No. 3 of 2001), the Ministry of Internal Affairs and Communications (MIC) provides identification codes for registered foreign conformity assessment bodies and other characters as follows.

Note that the MIC Notice No. 295 of 2003 (Identification Codes for Registered Foreign Conformity Assessment Bodies as Prescribed in Article 2 Paragraph (2) of the Ordinance for the Mark, Etc. Pursuant to the Act for Implementation of the Mutual Recognition between Japan and the European Community and the Republic of Singapore in Relation to Conformity Assessment of Specified Equipment) shall be repealed.

2. Other Characters

A registered foreign conformity assessment body shall assign Arabic numerals of ten characters or less to each of the technical regulations conformity certifications or construction types. In this case, it may add a prefix of five alphabetic characters or less to the Arabic numerals. However, with regard to the certified construction type of the following specified radio equipment (excluding those that have obtained a certification of construction type as prescribed in Supplementary Provisions Article 5 paragraph (4) of the MIC Ordinance for Partial Revision of the Ordinance for Regulating Radio Equipment (MIC Ordinance No. 119 of 2005)), it may assign the same characters, etc. to the construction type of specified radio equipment for which only the antenna type, structure or gain has been changed:

- (i) Specified radio equipment prescribed in Article 2 paragraph (1) item (19) of the

Certification Ordinance

(ii) Specified radio equipment prescribed in Article 2 paragraph (1) item (19) - 2 of the Certification Ordinance

(iii) Specified radio equipment prescribed in Article 2 paragraph (1) item (19) - 3 of the Certification Ordinance

(iv) Specified radio equipment prescribed in Article 2 paragraph (1) item (19) - 3-2 of the Certification Ordinance
