

RADIO STATIONS WHICH USE THE EQUIPMENT TO WHICH THE CONDITIONS DEFINED IN ARTICLE 58 OF THE ORDINANCE REGULATING RADIO EQUIPMENT DO NOT APPLY

(Article 58, Article 58.2 paragraph 1, Article 58.2.2 paragraph 1 of the Ordinance Regulating Radio Equipment)

Ministry of Posts and Telecommunications Notification No. 63

The radio stations which use the transmitting device or receiving device to which the conditions defined in each item of Article 58 or the conditions defined in the table of Article 58.2 paragraph 1 or Article 58.2.2 paragraph 1 of the Ordinance Regulating Radio Equipment do not apply shall be stipulated as follows based on the provisions of the proviso of Article 58, the proviso of Article 58.2 paragraph 1, and the proviso of Article 58.2.2 paragraph 1 of the Ordinance Regulating Radio Equipment (Radio Regulatory Commission Regulations No. 18 of 1950).

- 1 The radio station which uses F2A emissions, F2B emissions, F2D emissions, F2N emissions, or F2X emissions, and which uses the radio equipment defined in the items below.
 - (1) The radio equipment which uses emissions of a frequency of 54 MHz or lower, higher than 70 MHz to 142 MHz, higher than 162.0375 MHz to 335.4 MHz, or higher than 470 MHz
 - (2) Radio altimeters, radio distance measuring equipment, and telemeters (limited to those used at a meteorological aids station, an earth station, or a space station or those whose signal transmission rate exceeds 9,600 bits/s)
- 2 A signal messaging station and a radio determination station
