## VALUE OF RECEIVER INPUT VOLTAGE ANNOUNCED SEPARATELY BY THE MINISTER FOR PUBLIC MANAGEMENT, HOME AFFAIRS, POSTS AND TELECOMMUNICATIONS (RELATED TO DIGITAL MCA)

(Article 49.7.2 of the Ordinance Regulating Radio Equipment)

March 10, 1993 Ministry of Posts and Telecommunications Announcement No. 127

The value of receiver input voltage announced separately by the Minister for Public Management, Home Affairs, Posts and Telecommunications shall be stipulated as follows based on the provisions of Article 49.7.2 paragraph 1 item 2 b (2) of the Ordinance Regulating Radio Equipment (Radio Regulatory Commission Regulations No. 18 of 1950).

The receiver input voltage of the radio equipment of a land mobile station which performs digital MCA land mobile communication, a digital directive station, or a radio station which performs communication for testing digital MCA land mobile communication equipment (except the radio station which shares a transmitting device with a digital MCA control station), which uses emissions of a frequency of 1,500 MHz and in which the antenna power is automatically controlled so that it can be minimized, shall be 100  $\mu$ V or more.

However, the receiver input voltage shall be capable of being controlled by the instructions of a digital MCA control station as required.
