MNO	A telecommunications carrier that provides mobile communications services as telecommunications services (hereinafter simply referred to as "mobile communications services"), and establishes a radio station (including the succession of the status of licensee, etc., of the established radio station; the same applies hereinafter) or operates the same in relation to such services
MVNO	A telecommunications carrier that (1) provides mobile communications services using mobile communications services provided by an MNO or by connecting to an MNO network, and (2) does not establish or operate a radio station in relation to such services
BWA access service	An access service that connects to networks via a broadband mobile wireless access system (e.g., WiMAX) operating in the 2.5 GHz band
3.9-4th generation mobile communications access service	An access service that connects to networks via a 3.9-4th generation mobile communication system (LTE) using a mobile phone or similar device
5th generation mobile communications access service	An access service that connects to networks via a 5th generation mobile communication system using a mobile phone or similar device
intra-group transactions adjustment	An adjustment of two contracts to one instead of two when an MNO provides mobile phone or BWA services provided by another MNO in the same group as the MVNO in addition to its own services, on one mobile phone or a similar device. This applied, for example, to services by KDDI Group and SoftBank in relation to mobile phone terminals that are compatible with both LTE and BWA frequencies
SIM card type	An MVNO service using a SIM card (including a product with a built-in SIM card) that is provided for end users
communication module	An MVNO service for a module that is limited to communication for specific business purposes and directly provided for end users
simple resale	An MVNO service that is the same as the service provided by an MNO, and delivered by the MVNO to end users
re-wholesale	An MVNO service that is provided as wholesale telecommunications services to other MVNOs
secondary line service	A service in which an MNO provides mobile phone and BWA services provided by other MNOs as an optional service that can be used to switch from its own services in the event of, for example, a communication failure or disaster
FTTH access service	An access service that connects to networks via optical fiber circuits (including VDSL, which uses telephone lines in part in apartment complexes, etc.)
DSL access service	An access service (e.g., ADSL) that connects to networks via telephone lines (copper lines)
CATV access service	An access service that connects to networks via cable television lines (excluding those related to FTTH access services)
wireless fixed broadband access service	An access service that wirelessly connects to networks via a fixed indoor router
wireless fixed broadband access service (dedicated	A fixed wireless broadband access service in which the number of indoor routers connected to wireless equipment
type) wireless fixed broadband access service (shared type)	is controlled by telecommunications carriers A fixed wireless broadband access service in which the number of indoor routers connected to wireless equipment is not controlled by telecommunications carriers
