

About the Regional Informatization Advisor Dispatch System

Overview	To solve various issues faced by local communities, “ Regional Informatization Advisors “ with ICT expertise will be dispatched at the request of local governments, etc. that are considering initiatives using ICT, and they will provide advice on ICT utilization.
Targets	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Local public organization. NPOs, universities, chambers of commerce, etc. must be recommended by the Regional Bureau of Telecommunications or a local public organization to apply. • Local companies, etc. applying for subsidies must be recommended by a local public organization and must be conducting business in collaboration with a local public organization, etc. (Expanded from FY2025)
Advisor	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Assign the role of advisors to knowledgeable individuals, such as officials from advanced municipalities, university faculty members, and experts in CivicTech and related fields. • Depending on the details of the project, support will be provided by a team of multiple advisors.
Frequency/cost	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • For dispatches including on-site dispatches, up to 7 hours per day, and up to 3 times per year. • For online-only dispatches, up to a total of 21 hours. (Expanded from FY2025) • All travel expenses and fees for a dispatch will be borne by the MIC.

Dispatch applications for FY2025 will be accepted starting at noon on Friday, April 25. *The earliest possible dispatch date is scheduled for mid-May.
