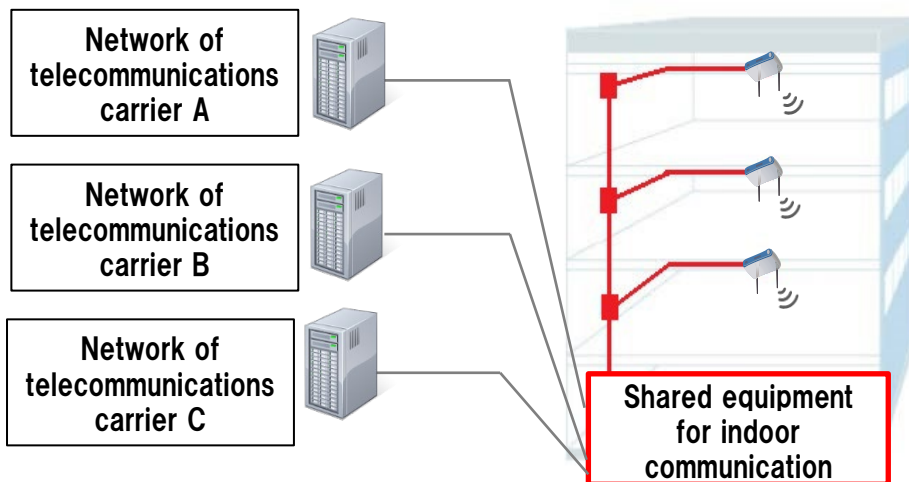


Overview of support for the enhancement of the indoor carrier-neutral hosting project in Indonesia

- The **Fund Corporation for the Overseas Development of Japan's ICT and Postal Services Inc. (JICT)**, in collaboration with dhost Global, Inc., a subsidiary of EXEO Group, Inc., announced that it will **provide support through loans and investments of up to 1 billion yen** for the **enhancement of the indoor carrier-neutral hosting project in Indonesia**.
- This support is related to the project approved for support on January 18, 2021*¹, and project approved for support on May 30, 2023*².
- This project **involves enhancing indoor antenna equipment procured from local mobile carriers to 5G, etc., and providing services to multiple telecommunications carriers while operating and maintaining the equipment**.
- By acquiring knowledge related to the construction and operation of next-generation communications such as 5G through this support, it is expected to provide opportunities for the expansion of 5G and other technologies to neighboring countries in Southeast Asia.

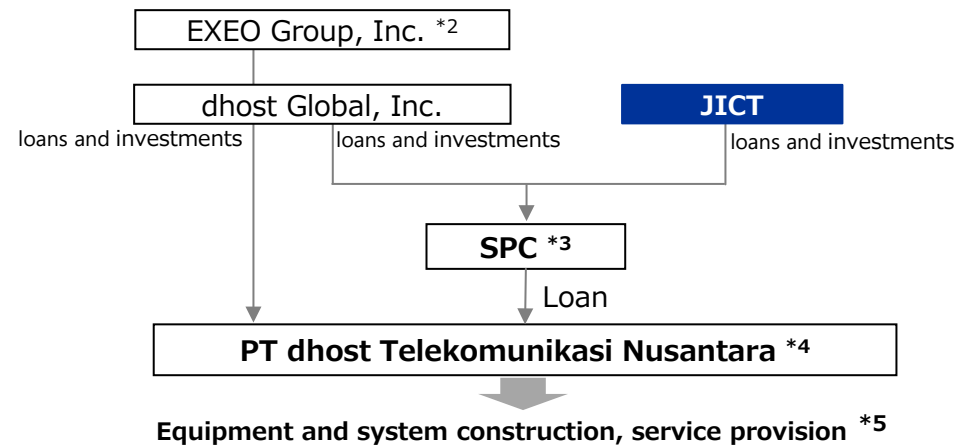
