

To people entering Japan

To bring your own **Wi-Fi** and/or **Bluetooth device(s)** into Japan, you must obtain technical regulations conformity certification in Japan – thus, only **devices carrying the technical standards compliance mark** are allowed to be used inside the country (Japan).

However, devices that fulfill the following conditions may be used for a limited period of **90 days or less** from entry to Japan.

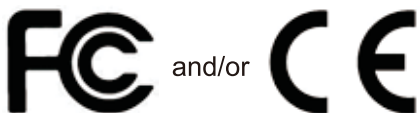


Technical standards compliance mark



Wi-Fi Devices

Devices carrying the **FCC certification** for the USA and the **CE mark** for Europe as well as devices displaying some kind of mark that explains certification for **Wi-Fi Alliance** (in other words, devices carrying approved logos).



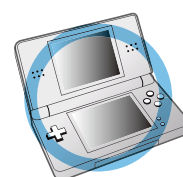
Examples of Wi-Fi Certified Logos



* Devices that do not display the above marks/logos may have applicable ones in user's manuals.

Smartphones, etc., can be connected to public wireless LAN spots and used.

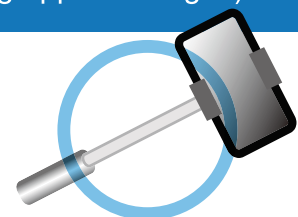
Note that communication is possible via tethering when using the 2.4GHz frequency band.

Bluetooth Devices

Bluetooth devices displaying some kind of mark that explains **Bluetooth SIG certified** (in other words, devices carrying approved logos).



- * NOTE
1. Usable frequencies are limited to just 2.4GHz band (indoors and outdoors), 5.2GHz band (indoors), 5.3GHz band (indoors) and 5.6GHz band (indoors and outdoors).
 2. If you enter Japan without obtaining the technical standard compliance mark for your device(s), and then use device(s) after 90 days have elapsed from entry, you may be subject to punishment for violating the Radio Law.
 3. In cases where devices, such as personal computers, are connected using a cable, as long as the connection is an Ethernet one (10BASE-T, 100BASE-TX, 1000BASE-T), these too can be used for up to 90 days without prior inspection by a telecommunications carrier.
